MALE LEOTARDS – Apologies for the delay in bringing you this information. We have a new novice/regional leotard for boys. Anyone requiring a novice/regional boy's leotard should go to the Elite International website. Click on Gymlink and put in the code EDG12 for Edgbarrow. You can buy the leotard directly from the website. Please allow one month for delivery. You may just get one for the 26th of this month if you ring and ask, they are usually very helpful. If you are a regional competitor and already have the Milano boy's competition leotard please continue to wear this one and also for League 3 and 2 too. You do not need to buy the new one until it needs replacing. We are phasing out the Milano competition leotard and will in future have the following options – a Quatro leotard (designed by Ray) for all members of the Elite groups, all League 1, NDP8 and BG Elite competitors and the new blue leotard for all other competitors. Before buying anything please see me for clarification.

FEMALE LEOTARDS – We are phasing out the Milano competition leotard and will in future have the following options – a Quatro leotard for all members of the Elite groups, all League 1, NDP8 and BG Elite competitors. All regional, League 3 and 2 competitors will wear the blue training leotard. You may continue to wear the Milano competition leotard until it needs replacing. Before buying anything please see me for clarification.

TRAINING ATTIRE – We would like all club members to train in leotards. This is compulsory for all ETC Elite Squad members and advisory for all others. Your coach will advise you.

ENGLISH CHAMPIONSHIPS – Although the first event is at the beginning of April we still do not have a confirmed handbook or a confirmed venue. Once we know what's happening we will let you know. As a guide we think the events will involve a qualification process for approximate levels League 2+ and NDP 5 to Elite.
